

Notes by Joy Mountain Ranch concerning From Give Him Fifteen – An Appeal to Heaven April 8, 2019 – Dutch Sheets

GiveHim 15 and Love Ministries were dedicated to praying for all the states and declaring that “Righteousness exalts a nation”. On day 59 of 70 days of prayer, they prayed for South Dakota.

We should decree the Preamble of the State of South Dakota: “We, the people of South Dakota grateful to Almighty God for our civil and religious liberties, in order to from a more perfect and independent government, establish justice, insure tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare and preserve to ourselves and to our posterity the blessings of liberty, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the state.”

It was mentioned that South Dakota was the “Stronghold State”. Dutch Sheets prophesied that there was something quite significant underway in this state and God was going to use the state to take down national strongholds. Always there is going to be an expression of truth coming out of South Dakota. There is always going to be great influence because God has placed that anointing on this state. In order to have influence, the people of the state are going to have to learn how to express ourselves the way God wills us to express ourselves. He also said that from this state, the nation will begin to be legislated.

God also said through Dutch Sheets that South Dakota desired truth and God taught her wisdom. Revelation knowledge was being poured out on the state because God says the state is His friend. He proclaimed that there was a strong apostolic prophetic mantle on the state and the voice of the Lord was upon the waters of the Ekklesia.

He also stated that the state was anointed with gladness because it loved righteousness and hated wickedness.

NOTE: (Joy Mountain Ranch) – May 1992 - Yesterday, as I was driving in to Rapid City to attend the Women's Aglow spring retreat, the words "**Love righteousness, desire purity, and hate wickedness**" kept coming up in my spirit. The speaker did something that was really neat at the end of her talk on the Bride of Christ, she asked everyone to close their eyes. She had several separate words from the Lord that she felt were for people that were there. As she read them, she told us if we felt the Holy Spirit quickening that word to us as a word for us, we were to raise our hand and someone would come around and anoint us with oil and pray to seal that word into our spirits.

The word that I felt was for me was "**You love righteousness, you desire holiness, and you hate wickedness**". God has called you to do battle against the spirits of wickedness in high places (not flesh and blood). And as you are faithful, God will give you the nations." Later, as I got home, I picked up the book I have been reading called "The Three Battlegrounds" by Francis Frangipane. One of the last chapters was God will Judge your Judgment and it was about the spirit of Babylon. He says that this spirit is the spirit of compromise with the world. You can identify it by three characteristics. 1) Pride, 2) Worldliness, and 3) Lust. for pleasure. The author goes

on to say that there is a people that not only come out of Babylon, but they rise up as an army against it. Rev.18:20 says that the saints, and apostles, and prophets are to rejoice because God is causing judgment to come to Babylon. These saints and apostles and prophets are people whose words and whose purity become a source of judgment upon the spirit of Babylon. Then he says this army is becoming a people that **HATES WICKEDNESS AND LOVES RIGHTEOUSNESS**, an army that as it follows Christ, initiates spiritual warfare against the various gates of hell. We are to declare "BABYLON HAS FALLEN".

So very applicable to the Black Hills and the rest of South Dakota. For a better understanding of righteousness and justice, one should read my first book, "The Mountain Belongs to the Remnant". God gave me a great understanding of this when I was in North Dakota.
